Thank you for signing up for a Manuscript Consultation or Critique with one of our presenters.

You can submit: A full picture book manuscript (1,000 words or less, no illustrations), the first 10 pages of a Chapter Book, Middle Grade or Young Adult novel, or up to 10 pages of a Nonfiction text. For novels, you may also include a one-page synopsis (not required). Do not include a cover or query letter.

Title your email Agent Day Consultation (or Critique). Send it to inlandnw@scbwi.org. All materials must be received on or before **March 12, 2021**.

Due to the number of critiques, we **will not** be able to send individual reminders. If you do not submit by the deadline, you will lose your spot. Refunds will not be issued for late or unsubmitted work. Refunds will not be issued for missed consultation appointments.

A completed SCBWI Gold Form critique will be returned to you by email on or before April 14, 2021.

Please review specific formatting instructions below.

Manuscripts must be formatted according to industry standards.

If you are including a novel synopsis, the order should be 10 manuscript pages followed by a one-page synopsis.
